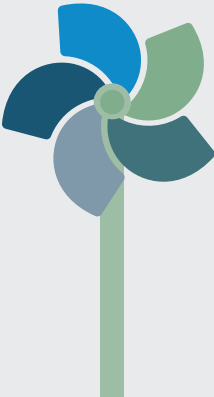

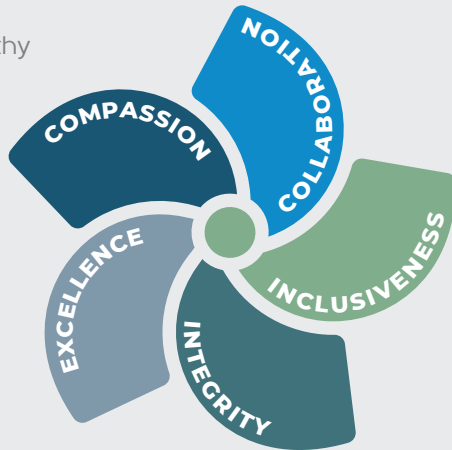

A Message from Board Chairman Michael Hays



With the continued pandemic, 2021 brought another year of uncertainty and change for CAPS. But we are pleased with the way staff and volunteers continued to adapt to meet the needs of kids and families in Elkhart County.

Recognizing the needs of the community, 2021 saw the opening of a new Family Resource Center focused on primary prevention. With services designed to break down

barriers and fill gaps, the Family Resource Center has been assisting families in crisis with either connection to appropriate resources or offering brief case management that may not be available elsewhere. The CAPS staff and leadership teams are proud to report the successes from the Resource Center, where individual self-reflection and peer-to-peer learning have created strategies to help strengthen families.

Throughout 2021, CAPS continued efforts with Prevent 360° by partnering with all seven public school corporations in Elkhart County to roll out an evidenced-based

curriculum that focuses on educating and empowering children and adults with information and strategies to prevent, recognize, and respond appropriately to child abuse, neglect, bullying, cyberbullying, and digital abuse dangers.

Additionally, CAPS partnered with The SOURCE, Campus Center for Young Children, and the Monique Burr Foundation to develop a pre-k curriculum focused on child abuse and neglect prevention. This groundbreaking work is currently piloted throughout the community in various preschools as well as in a 1-1 setting with the CAPS Healthy Families team. It should be set to release

in the 2022-2023 school year locally and nationally.

In the meantime, 2021 saw many continued successes in the CASA, Healthy Families, Parent Aide, Supervised Visitation, and Community Education Programs. CAPS also continued serving some of the community's most vulnerable victims through its important work in the Child and Family Advocacy Center, which had near record service numbers in 2021. I was gratified to lead the Board of Directors and thereby play a small role in all this dedicated service to the children and families of Elkhart County. We look forward to even greater impact in 2022.

Our Program Impacts

Healthy Families

Healthy Families is a perinatal, evidence-based home visiting service, and part of CAPS “upstream” prevention strategy. Healthy Families improves outcomes for two generations by supporting positive maternal and child health practices and boosting family protective factors.

Community Education

Community Education focuses on parenting support and community empowerment. Triple P: Positive Parenting Program teaches effective parenting strategies. Darkness to Light teaches the signs of neglect, abuse, and sexual abuse.

Parent Aide

Parent Aide is a voluntary, short term, home visiting program which aims to assist families by providing support in various ways. Parent Aide assists families through helping parents build their self-confidence, self-esteem and coping skills. All while working towards the family’s individual goals and connecting them to other community resources.

Family Resource Center

Family Resource Center is a new initiative at CAPS that began in 2021. The Family Resource Center primarily focuses on prevention programming and promoting the protective framework for families.

Supervised Visitation

The Supervised Visitation program provides a safe place for children to have regular, consistent visitation with their non-custodial parent (or grandparent). Facilitators offer parenting skills to the noncustodial parent as needed by demonstrating, offering suggestions/guidance, and redirections.

Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA)

The Elkhart County CASA program provides a voice in the court for children who have been victims of abuse and neglect. Advocacy is supplied by community volunteers whenever possible.

The CFAC program puts the needs of child victims first during an abuse or neglect investigation. A child-friendly, neutral environment helps children feel safe to tell their story to specially trained forensic interviewers.

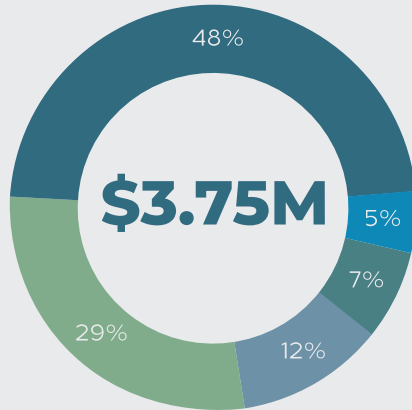

2021 Financial Data

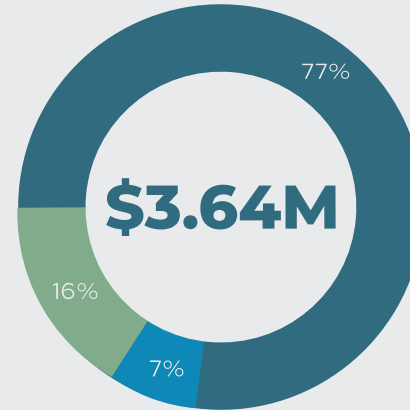
Revenue by Source
